Materials needed:

- o Paper lunch bag
- Scissors
- o Glue
- o Crayons
- Manatee cutouts (see additional page)

Steps:

- 1. Cut out the manatee body parts
- 2. Glue the head to the "bottom" part of the lunch bag
- 3. 3. Glue the flippers to either side
- 4. Glue the mouth under the heads, towards the fold
- 5. Glue the fluke to where the lunch bag would open.

Optional: Dugong puppet

- Use the provided fluke for the tail
- o When coloring, color over the nails, as dugongs do not have nails
