





Name	Picture	Description
Narwhal		A medium-sized toothed whale that possesses a large "tusk" from a protruding canine tooth. It lives year-round in the Arctic waters
Emperor Penguin		The tallest and heaviest of all living penguin species and is endemic to Antarctica.
Polar Bear		A marine mammal that spends most of their lives on the sea ice of the Arctic Ocean. They have a thick layer of body fat and a water-repellant coat that insulates them from the cold air and water.
Elephant seal		Named because adult males have large noses that resemble an elephant's trunk.
Blue Whale		The largest animals ever known to have lived on Earth. These magnificent marine mammals rule the oceans at up to 100 feet long and upwards of 200 tons. Their tongues alone can weigh as much as an elephant. Their hearts, as much as an automobile.
